

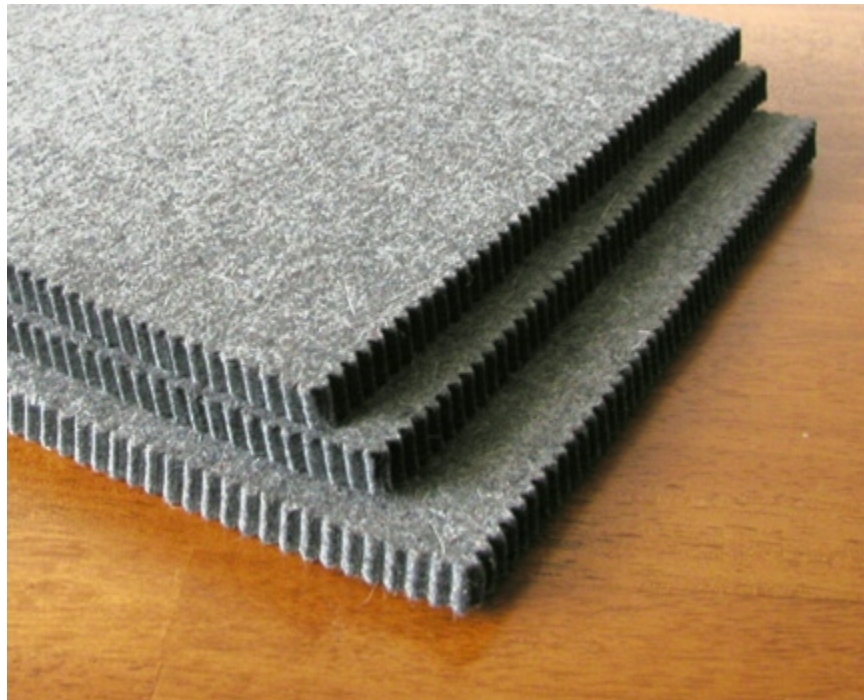
## Quieting My Serger

Some folks are not prepared for the louder noise of a serger compared to a sewing machine.

Standard domestic sergers all stitch at a rate of 1300 stitches per minute compared to modern day domestic (non-industrial) sewing machines which stitch at a rate of 840 to 850 stitches per minute.

Some solutions to making it quieter are – folks put a folded towel, yoga mat, shelf liner under their serger.

If you want a really reliable method – use a class typewriter mat – it really does dampen the noise better than most of the other choices above.
